Key Growth & Learning Results / Children and Youth

PYC Arts & Technology High School

- 310** 9–12th grade youth enrolled
- 79%** Graduation-eligible seniors earned their high school diploma
- 100%** Graduates had a plan for post-secondary education, vocational training, military service or gainful employment

2018 Summer Friends Enrichment

- 112** K–5th grade children enrolled
- 100%** Children maintained or increased grade level reading skills for the 10th consecutive summer. NO Summer Slide!
- 36%** Children who were below grade level at the beginning of summer made .5 years growth or more in 7 weeks
- 100%** Families reported program satisfaction

Out-of-School-Time Enrichment

- 115** K–5th grade children enrolled
- 64%** At or above grade level in reading
- 60%** Demonstrated positive self-management behaviors
- 100%** Parents participated in at least one family engagement activity

Capri Afterschool Youth Arts & Enrichment Camp Capri, CAST, Remix, Capri Apprentices

- 90** Middle and high school youth enrolled
- 73%** Demonstrated positive outcomes toward learning
- 64%** Improved or maintained social skills and positive behaviors
- 100%** Learned at least one new arts-related skill

Cultural / Creative Arts Results

Capri Theater

- 3,562** Visitors attended Legends @ the Capri, Capri Glee!, Summer Camp Capri, and CAST performances, First Thursday Films @ the Capri and SPCO chamber series and family music concerts.
- 59** Clients rented the Capri for a wide variety of productions and events for durations from 2 hours up to 3 weeks.
- 15%** Rental clients were Northside residents or businesses who received discounted neighborhood rental rates.
