

PCYC's Impact-at-a-Glance

July 1, 2021- June 30, 2022

This report covers a period in time when the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic periodically diminished or intensified. This affected student attendance in our education programs and at our health clinic, as well as audience participation at the Capri. COVID disruptions often demanded immediate attention and required all managers and staff members to make rapid changes in PCYC's operations. Despite these ongoing uncertainties PCYC continued to serve our youth, families and community in many ways and with compassion throughout this time.

Key Growth & Learning Results/Children and Youth

PYC Arts & Technology High School

A contract alternative high school in partnership with Minneapolis Public Schools, PYC provides young people with a solid path to graduation and beyond, delivered by talented, dedicated staff members who are passionate about this work.

Bright Futures K-5 Engagement at PCYC/Summer and After-School Programs

Serving Northside youth for nearly 40 years, Bright Futures builds scholars' brain power, confidence and creativity with a focus on academic enrichment and fun, imaginative arts and recreational activities.

Scholars participated in diverse and engaging experiences that promoted academic enrichment, social-emotional development, and skill-building, including virtual literacy programming, STEM learning, mindfulness activities, gardening and healthy eating, art clubs, and field trips.


PCYC has sustained this mission by following these operating principles:
