
This Annual Report covers a period in time when PCYC (and society, in general) is still keenly affected by the disruptions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. Student attendance in our high school and K-5 programs has increased but is nowhere near pre-pandemic levels. The number of students served by the Capri Best Buy Teen Tech Center and our health clinic also increased, and in-person audiences returned to the Capri, but not as readily as hoped. Despite these ongoing uncertainties, PCYC continued to serve our youth, families, and community effectively, creatively, and with compassion throughout the year.

PYC Arts & Technology High School

A contract alternative high school in partnership with Minneapolis Public Schools, PYC provides young people with a solid path to graduation and beyond, delivered by talented, dedicated staff members who are passionate about this work.



9-12th grade youth enrolled.

Graduation-eligible seniors earned their high school diploma.

Graduates had a plan for post-secondary education, vocational training, military service or gainful employment.

PYC students were placed into full-time, paid, educational summer internships at the University of Minnesota's Urban Research and Outreach-Engagement Center in North Minneapolis. This partnership with the U of M is being expanded for the coming year.

Serving Northside youth for nearly 69 years, PCYC's K-5 program builds scholars' brain power, confidence and creativity with a focus on academic enrichment and fun, imaginative arts and recreational activities.



121 K-5th grade scholars enrolled in after-school and summer programs

STEM kits filled with a variety of materials, including how-to videos, were provided to scholars and families so that they could do STEM enrichment activities at home, together.

Capri Best Buy Teen Tech Center

The Capri Best Buy Teen Tech Center is an amazing, after-school, state-of-the-art technology space where teens get hands-on experience in audio recording and production, 3D printing, digital photography, video, computer programming, graphic design, and much more.

Youth also learned valuable professional development and workforce-readiness skills to help them prepare for their futures.

The Capri

The recently expanded, renovated Capri is a wonderful, welcoming theater, rental space and gathering place that provides the Northside and metro-wide community with countless opportunities to experience and produce art, to create and implement ideas, and to Be Together.

Youth served through Capri and Capri partner-produced programs, community events, and Capri rental programs/presentations.

Different types of artistic, civic, and community events were held at the Capri including theater and dance company performances, concerts, educational trainings and competitions, film screenings, candidate forums, the West Broadway Farmers Market, annual meetings, birthday parties and multiday conferences. The Capri now serves as the 5th Ward Polling Station as well.

This clinic on the PCYC campus provides free, comprehensive physical and mental health care services to PYC and North Minneapolis teens.

PCYC has sustained this mission by following these operating principles:


- · Achieve life-changing results for program participants.


